KINDERGARTEN AND FIRST GRADE CLASSROOMS



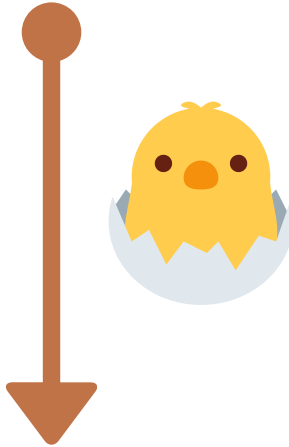
Each spring, Iowa State University Extension and Outreach-Linn County & Linn County Farm Bureau partner to offer a unique, up-close agriculture experience to **kindergarten & first grade classrooms in Linn County**. Two rounds will be offered from March to May. Classrooms will be provided a kit that includes materials to incubate 7 fertile chicken eggs. The program will run for four weeks & will include optional visits, virtual resources, support for teachers, & curriculum with cross-curricular activities, lessons, books, games, & resources. Students will explore the poultry industry & identify the basic needs of a growing chick during the incubation period.
