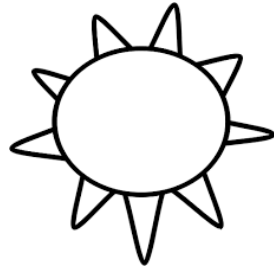


Iowa Farm Charm



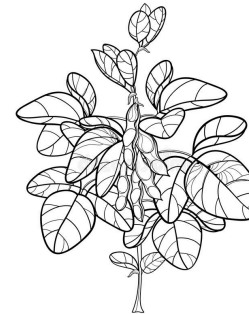

Iowa usually has nice weather for growing plants. We usually get enough rain, but we also have sunshine to help growth.

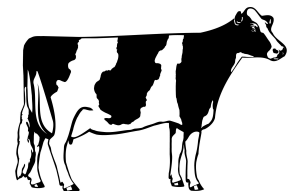
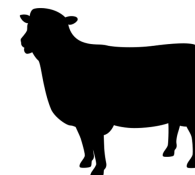
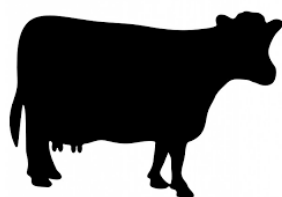
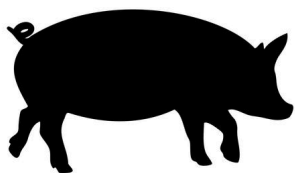
