


## **Splash Zone Target**




## **Splash Zone Graph**



#### **Erosion Control Practices**



Farmers use several methods to conserve soil. Write the number of the practice below in the correct box in the picture.

- **1. Contour Planting**: planting crops around the curve of a hill rather than up and down the hill
- **2. Terraces**: wide ridges that go around a hill to prevent water from rushing down the hill too fast
- **3. Forest and Grass Areas**: steep hillsides are kept covered in trees or grass rather than being cleared for cropland
- **4. Grassed Waterways**: planting grass and not plowing low areas in a field where water usually runs
- **5. Windbreak**: rows of trees planted to slow down the wind and prevent soils from blowing
