
GRAFTING

Grafting is when a shoot or bud of one tree in inserted into or joined to the stem, branch or root of another tree so that the two grow together. Reasons:

- Grow a certain variety of fruit
- 2. Obtain a shorter tree
- Protect against diseases and pests
- 4. Increase or speed up production.

- 2. Is the rootstock the bottom or the top of the graft?
- 3. Is the scion the bottom or the top of the graft?
