Types of Aquaculture Systems

Wild Caught

Seafood supplied through fishing. The breeding, feeding, and growth of these fish are not managed by humans in any way. They are harvested from the ocean or other natural waters using nets, trawls, or other devices

Fish Farm

Raising fish commercially in tanks or other man-made enclosures such as ponds or concrete fish runs. These farms manage their water and the growth of the fish from the fertilization of eggs until harvest.

Cage System Fish Farm

Similar to a fish farm, where a farmer manages the breeding, growth, and harvest of fish, but fish are grown and managed in cages in the ocean or other natural waters rather than in a man-made pond or fish run.
